Thank you to everyone who responded to the questionnaire concerning whether the Town should keep the Recycling Container in Youngsville. Due to the many comments and requests made on these questionnaires, we have made some changes concerning how Youngsville recycles. During the April Board Meeting, the Town Board voted to go back to curbside recycling for any resident that wishes to participate. The fee is \$5.30 per residence and will include a 65 gallon roll cart. It will be picked up every other week at curbside. Please fill out the application below, sign it and return it to Town Hall by May 31st. Once we have received the schedule from Waste Industries it will be forwarded to you as soon as possible, as well as being posted on the Town's Webpage at www.townofyoungsville.org. Just click on "Taxes, Utilities, and Services".

With the ability to recycle at home, the Recycling Container located at N.E. Railroad Street will be removed July 1st. Anyone not wishing to participate in curbside recycling can take their recycling to the Franklin County Convenience Center located at 529 Park Avenue (1A-North, just past the Hampton Village Apartment Complex). They are open Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday from 7am - 7pm. You can go to the Franklin County's Webpage at www.co.franklin.nc.us and click on "Solid Waste" to get more information.
